

the date of the compliance with all the provisions of this subdivision, the preferred status given by the provisions of subsection M, if—

“(1) The mortgage is endorsed upon the vessel’s documents in accordance with the provisions of this section; Conditions.

“(2) The mortgage is recorded as provided in subsection C, together with the time and date when the mortgage is so endorsed;

“(3) An affidavit is filed with the record of such mortgage to the effect that the mortgage is made in good faith and without any design to hinder, delay, or defraud any existing or future creditor of the mortgagor or any lienor of the mortgaged vessel;

“(4) The mortgagee does not stipulate that the mortgagee waives the preferred status thereof; and

“(5) The mortgagee is a citizen of the United States and for the purposes of this act the Reconstruction Finance Corporation shall, in addition to those designated in sections 37 and 38 of this Act, be deemed a citizen of the United States.” Status of Reconstruction Finance Corporation. [CHAPTER 320.]

AN ACT

To authorize the furnishing of steam from the central heating plant to the Federal Reserve Board, and for other purposes. June 27, 1935. [H. R. 7652.] [Public, No. 169.]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the Secretary of the Interior through the National Park Service be, and he is hereby, authorized to furnish steam from the central heating plant for the use of the Federal Reserve Board on the property which has been acquired by it in squares east of 87 and east of 88 in the District of Columbia: *Provided,* That the Federal Reserve Board agrees to pay for the steam furnished at reasonable rates, not less than cost, as may be determined by the Secretary of the Interior: *Provided further,* That the Federal Reserve Board agrees to provide the necessary connections with the Government mains at its own expense and in a manner satisfactory to the Secretary of the Interior. District of Columbia. Central heating plant to furnish steam to Federal Reserve Board.

*Provisos.* Payment therefor.

SEC. 2. That hereafter the rates to be paid for steam furnished to the Corcoran Gallery of Art, the buildings, old and new, of the Pan American Union, the American Red Cross Buildings, and such other non-Federal public buildings as are or hereafter may be authorized to receive steam from the central heating plant shall be determined by the Secretary of the Interior. Rates for designated buildings to be determined.

SEC. 3. That all Acts and parts of Acts which may be inconsistent or in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict. Inconsistent laws repealed.

[CHAPTER 322.]

AN ACT

To authorize participation by the United States in the Interparliamentary Union. June 28, 1935. [S. 2276.] [Public, No. 170.]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That an appropriation of \$20,000 annually is hereby authorized, \$10,000 of which shall be for the annual contribution of the United States toward the maintenance of the Bureau of the Interparliamentary Union for the promotion of international arbitration; and \$10,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to assist in meeting the expenses Interparliamentary Union.
